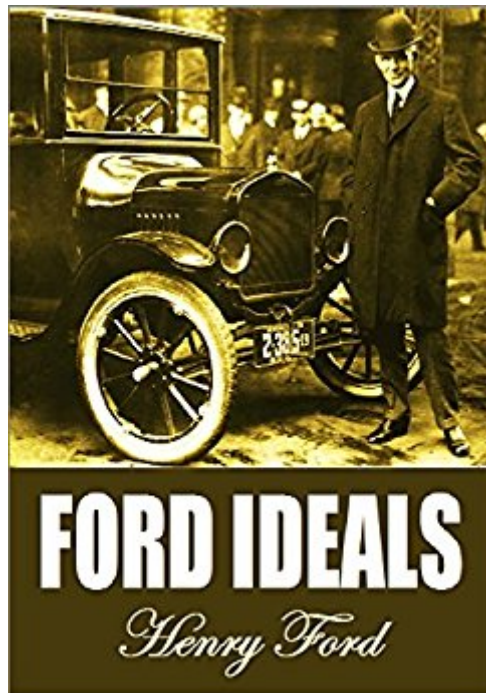

Synopsis
